

DiCentra Organiser Plus – Installation Guide

Requirements

DiCentra Organiser Plus needs the following computing resources:

- A computer running Windows 10, 8, 8.1 or 7, Windows Vista SP1 or later or Windows XP SP3 or later. Either 32-bit or 64-bit systems should be suitable.
- Microsoft's .NET 4 Client Profile. If you have installed DiCentra 4 this will already be installed.
- A network-connection to download the software.
- Enough disk space to make a copy of the input images.

Installation

1. Download *DiCentra Organiser Plus* from www.wilburimaging.com/dicentra
Note: *Organiser Plus* is expected to eventually be part of a future version of *DiCentra*. For this reason the software is time-limited. You will need to download a new version about once a year until then.
2. Right-click on *DCOP.zip* and select *Extract All* from the pop-up menu. A folder called *DCOP* will be created.
3. Inside that folder *double-click* on the *setup.exe* file to install the software.
4. If your machine does not have .NET 4 installed you will be told at this stage and should be provided with a button that takes you to the Microsoft site from which it can be loaded and installed. Follow the instructions provided, and then go back to step 4 above.
If you are not directed to the download site *see below* for installing .NET 4 and then go back to step 3.
5. After installation you can access the User Guide from within *Organiser Plus* using:
Help > Organiser Plus User Guide

Known Bugs and Limitations

1. Portfolio competitions are not supported.
2. **Reject wrong colour space** and **Reject wrong size** are not available as separate options.

Installation - .NET 4 Client Profile

It is likely that the *.NET Framework 4 Client Profile* will already be installed on Windows 7, 8, 8.1 and 10 installations. However, it may be necessary to install it if you are using Vista or XP SP3 or XP SP4. To do so:

1. Google ".net 4 download".
One of the early results should be headed something like "*Download Microsoft .NET Framework 4 (Web Installer)*". Click on it and then the click on the *Download* button on the page that is displayed.
2. You can then *Save* the download and *double-click* it to complete the installation.
Alternatively, you can select the *Run* option to do the installation immediately.

- If you click on one of the other results shown in the Google search, ensure that it is a Microsoft site and that it offers to provide *.NET 4 Framework* or *.NET 4 Client Profile*.
- If you can't find the right site enter the following URL into your browser and use the *Download* button on the page that is displayed.
